


Akasaka Asada





Founded in 1659, this traditional Japanese ryotei offers refined cuisine and exceptional hospitality. Once the heart of Tokyo's geisha culture, Akasaka has evolved into a business district, yet Asada remains one of the few ryotei still in existence. Hie Shrine





Adjacent to The Capitol Hotel Tokyu, Hie Shrine has been a Tokugawa Shogun and Imperial Family guardian since 1590. The shrine enshrines the deity of Mt. Hie in Kyoto, symbolising progress and well-being. Guests can experience a sacred Shinto ritual, where priests perform a prayer for individual wishes at the Hall of Worship, a restricted area not usually accessible to visitors.
